Fiber optic internet requires a compatible router or an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP. The ONT converts the fiber signal into Ethernet, which you then connect to a router's WAN port. Most modern routers support fiber input via SFP or WAN ports labeled for fiber or GPON connections . High-performance options include Wi-Fi 6 and Wi-Fi 7 routers, which can handle multi-gigabit speeds and multiple devices simultaneously .

4G LTE Backup and Hybrid Routers

Many routers now support 4G LTE or 5G failover, allowing your network to automatically switch to cellular data if your fiber connection fails. This is useful during outages caused by power loss, cable damage, or ISP issues . Some routers, like the Eero Max 7 paired with an Eero Signal dongle, provide automatic 4G LTE backup. Other Wi-Fi 7 routers, such as ASUS RT-BE96U or NETGEAR RS300, also support USB-based cellular modems for failover .

- ASUS RT-BE86U BE6800: Wi-Fi 7, quad-core CPU, 10G WAN/LAN, dual 2.5G ports, supports USB 4G/5G backup, ideal for high-speed fiber and multiple devices .
- NETGEAR Nighthawk RS300: Tri-band Wi-Fi 7, 2.5G WAN/LAN, USB port for 4G LTE failover, compact design, suitable for gaming and streaming .
- GL.iNet GL-MT6000 (Flint 2): Wi-Fi 6, supports fiber speeds up to 6Gbps, access point mode, and 4G LTE backup via USB modem .
- Eero Max 7 with Eero Signal: Mesh Wi-Fi 7 system with optional 4G LTE backup dongle, automatically switches during fiber outages .

Setup Overview

- Install the ONT: Connect the fiber cable from the wall outlet to the ONT and power it on.
- Connect Router to ONT: Use an Ethernet cable from the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port.
- Enable 4G Backup: If your router supports USB cellular modems or built-in LTE, configure failover in the router's admin panel.
- Test Connection: Verify fiber speeds and simulate an outage to ensure 4G LTE failover works .

- Ensure the router supports your fiber plan's speed (multi-gigabit if needed).
- Check the number of Ethernet ports for wired devices.
- Look for Wi-Fi 6 or 7 for future-proofing and better device handling.
- Confirm 4G LTE bands are compatible with your cellular provider.
- Consider routers with built-in VPN, parental controls, and security features for added protection .
