- Rocky or gravelly soil: Requires a mortar or sand layer to prevent cable damage from sharp edges .
- Warning tape: Placed 0.2 meters above the cable to indicate its presence and comply with safety standards .
- Separation from power lines: Maintain 0.3–0.6 meters to avoid electromagnetic interference .

- NEC (U.S.): Specifies 0.6–1.2 meters depending on soil type, traffic load, and frost line considerations .
- ETSI (Europe): Suggests 0.8–1.0 meters, with 0.5 meters allowed in urban ducts .
